

# ECB Clubmark Process

## Step 1

### ECB Clubmark Registration

Managed by your local Cricket Development Manager

## Step 2

### Actively work towards and Support

Clubs actively work towards the criteria within ECB Clubmark.  
This step involves completing the ECB Clubmark 'Evidence File Checklist'

## Step 3

### ECB Clubmark Assessment

Divided into two elements:

- 1 – Assessment of the ECB Clubmark Evidence File
- 2 – ECB Clubmark Site Visit

## Step 4

### ECB Clubmark Annual Health Check

Annual review of all ECB Clubmark Accredited clubs  
to ensure they are maintaining ECB Clubmark status  
This is a self declaration process.

## Step 5

### ECB Clubmark Re-accreditation

Every 3 years, ECB Clubmark accredited clubs will be re-accredited.  
This will involve review of their ECB Clubmark Evidence File  
and an ECB Clubmark Site Visit

## Step 6

### Withdrawal of ECB Clubmark status

The process by which the ECB can withdraw ECB Clubmark status from  
any cricket club if they are not maintaining ECB Clubmark standards.

## Step 7

### ECB Clubmark External Moderation

The process of an independent company moderating ECB Clubmark  
accredited clubs to ensure high quality process and procedures are maintained.
